“My mother loves going and it has been a life saver for me.”

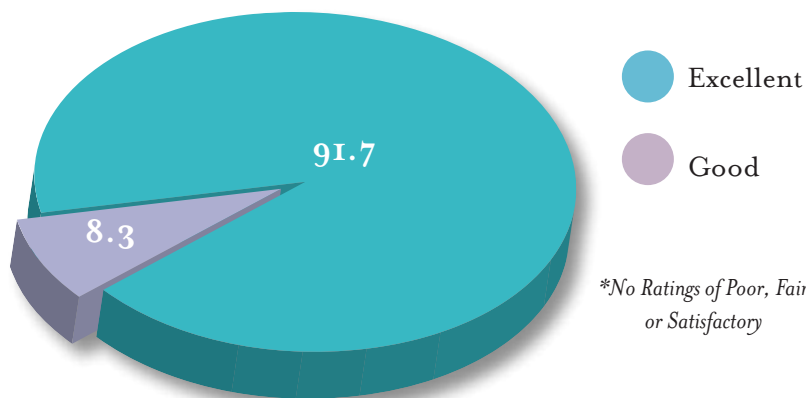

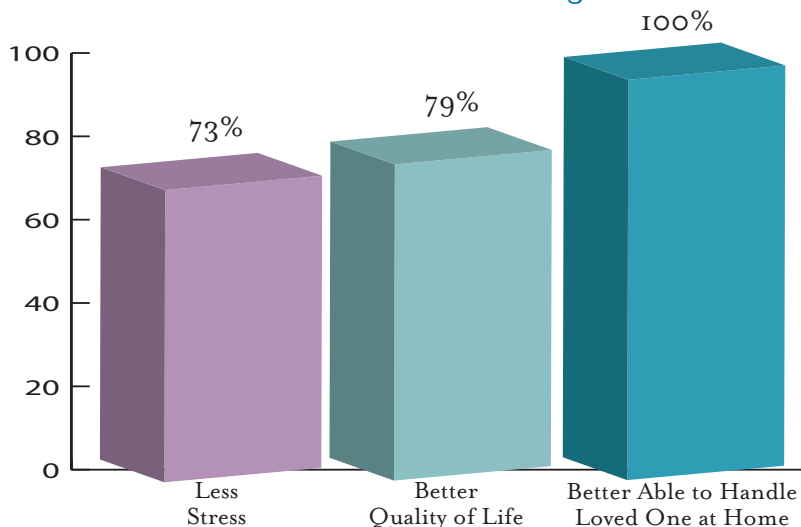


A day center for adults with mild to moderate dementia
